Elena Popova is a plant physiologist and genebank manager with a particular interest in biodiversity conservation ex situ. She is an expert in development and implementation of in vitro and cryopreservation technologies for biobanking clonally propagated crops and wild plants at risk of extinction.

She has worked as a Genebank program scientist at Global Crop Diversity Trust (Germany), as a researcher at the University of Guelph (Canada), National Agrobiodiversity Center (Republic of Korea) and has strong professional ties with the network of plant genebanks and conservation centers worldwide as a consultant and coordinator of international projects.

At her current position as a Head of All-Russian Cell Culture Collection, she is responsible for operations and strategic development of the Russia's largest collection of medicinal plant cell lines used in biotechnological production of phytochemicals for research, pharmacology, and nutrition.
