Prof. Roland JAHNS

Roland Jahns performed his medical studies -including his doctoral thesis- at the University of Würzburg (1984-1991) followed by a CEA-Fellowship at the University of Nice/Sophia Antipolis, France (Postdoc 1993-94).

From 1995 on, he was cardiology fellow at the Department of Internal Medicine (University Hospital Würzburg), obtained his speciality “internal medicine” in 2000, and “cardiology” in 2002.

2008 he was nominated Professor of Internal Medicine.

Since 2011, he is head of the centralized Interdisciplinary Bank of Biomaterials and Data of the Medical Faculty of Würzburg at the University Hospital Würzburg (which is full ESBB-member since 2012), and in 2013 was appointed full Professor for Translational Medicine.

Since 2011, he is Vice Chair of the competent Ethics Committee of the University of Würzburg and appointed member of the Biobank-TF of the Working Party of the German Medical Ethics Committees. Since 2013, he is the German representative in the BBMRI ELSI Services, and since 2019 member of the Steering Committee of the German Biobank Alliance.
