## Poster:

Poster presentation 10 min + 10 min discussion

Design of a poster of scientific content:

#### 1. poster layout and content:

- Logo of the University of Lübeck (see corporate design) as well as of the host institute/ university/ company
- concise poster title
- headline: students name (as the case may be: co-workers, supervisor)
- composition:
  - short introduction
  - methods (and materials)
  - results
  - discussion
  - abstract and outlook
  - literature, acknowledgment to supervisor, laboratory, institute, etc.
- in total: a clear and ordered design

#### 2. text:

- short and comprehensible sentences
- less text, more figures
- spacing: min: 1, 5
- type size:
  - text: type size 26 or 28
    - poster title: about 60

# topics: type size of about 48

- same typeface for the entire poster

#### 3. figures/tables:

Figures must be self-explanatory. Do not forget the legend as well as mention them in the text. Do not use too many colors.

#### 4. tips for the presentation:

Explanation of the poster in an abbreviate form:

- short description of the problem/ some research background?
- short explanation of the applied methods and why they have been used
- description of the results
- short outlook on further work or alternative methods for solving the problem
- DO NOT GO TOO MUCH INTO DETAIL. The examiners will ask you.

## Talk:

#### talk 10 min + 10 min discussion

#### 1. layout and content:

- uniform layout for the entire presentation
- concise title
- in total: a clear and ordered design; see: corporate design
- composition:
  - (overview)
  - short introduction
  - methods
  - results/discussion
  - abstract and outlook
  - acknowledgment to supervisor, laboratory, institute, etc.
- preferably save for power point as a pdf; there use NO animation

#### 2. text:

- as less text as possible, keyword only  $\rightarrow$  NO sentences
- "take home message" for imported results
- spacing: min: 1, 5
- type size: min. 16 (Headings > 20)
- same typeface for the entire presentation

#### 3. talk:

- speak slowly, loudly and clearly, face the audience
- use a laser pointer to highlight details on your slides
- explain the whole content on every slide (remove details that you have not time to explain; as rule max. 1 minute per slide)
- practice your presentation!!!
- IMPORTANT: Introduction to your topic max. 3-5 minutes. The results are the most important part of your talk!!!
