

Awarding of scholarships within the framework of the emergency program for the support for refugee scientists from Ukraine

From the funds of the emergency program for the support of refugee scientists from Ukraine, the university provides scholarships for the support of scientists who have at least an academic master's degree or a comparable degree in a university course of study coming from Ukraine. Funding is provided for research projects at an institute or clinic of the University of Lübeck, which are carried out in coordination with a scientific host.

Funding is provided in accordance with the guidelines for the awarding of scholarships within the framework of the emergency program.

The scholarship amounts to a maximum of 1.350€ per month, initially awarded for a period of six months, an extension of the funding to a maximum of 12 months is possible.

Application procedure:

The application can be made at any time. A decision on possible funding will be made within four weeks of receipt of the application.

The application documents must be submitted in German or English. The following documents must be enclosed with the application documents:

- a) Application form,
- b) curriculum vitae,
- c) list of publications,
- d) a self-developed and self-written research proposal (a detailed and precise statement of the research project) including the presentation of previous research work (a total of maximum five pages of maximum 3,000 characters without spaces plus, if applicable, a maximum of two additional pages for graphics), which has been agreed upon with the designated scientific supervisor,
- e) time schedule of the planned research work,
- f) confirmation of supervision by the designated scientific host at the University of Lübeck, which refers to the scientific project and assures the provision of a workplace by the host institute/clinic,
- g) Letter of motivation including a statement of financial circumstances,
- h) university degree certificate.

If the scientific project takes place within the framework of a doctoral project, the corresponding legal framework and requirements must be observed.
